Lt.j.g. Jeffrey Shelton is a native of Alta Loma, California. In 2001 he enlisted in the Navy and reported to Recruit Training Command Great Lakes, Illinois in 2002. Following Master-at-Arms "A" School, he reported aboard Naval Support Activity La Maddalena, Italy where he was selected to attend the Department of Defense Military Working Dog Handlers course at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas. Subsequent assignments as a handler included Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, Naval Submarine Base New London, Groton, Connecticut and individual augmentee deployments to Iraq and Afghanistan supporting counter-insurgency operations with combat elements of the Army and Marine Corps. After separating from the Navy in 2009, he attended Mt.
