Lt. Christina Danai is a native of Las Vegas, Nevada and a graduate of the United States Naval Academy, where she earned her Bachelor of Science in History and commission in 2012. She holds an Executive Master of Business Administration from the Naval Postgraduate School.

Lt. Danai is a Surface Warfare Officer, serving in four ships – USS San Diego (LPD 22) as First Division Officer in Deck Department, USS Lake Erie (CG 70) as Damage Control Assistant, USS Fort Worth (LCS 3) and a plank owner of USS Detroit (LCS 7) as Electronic Materials Officer with LCS Crew 103.

Ashore, she served as Maintenance Officer at Beachmaster Unit ONE, planning and executing the Lighter Amphibious Resupply Cargo (LARC) Service Life Extension Program (SLEP) and was a Master Training Specialist instructor, teaching Damage Control, Rules of the Road, Leadership, and Ship Handling to ensigns at the Basic Division Officer Course (BDOC) and the Junior Officer of the Deck (JOOD) course at Surface Warfare Officer School, San Diego.

Lt. Danai presently serves as Chief Engineer in USS Manchester (LCS 14) Gold with LCS Crew 205.
