LIEUTENANT CHRISTOPHER HALLISSY N3 SEA COMBAT DIVISION ASW/SUW WARFARE TACTICS INSTRUCTOR, NAVAL SURFACE AND MINE WARFIGHTING DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Lt. Christopher Hallissy's career began in February of 2004 as an enlisted Cryptologic Technician (Technical) and has been marked by numerous deployments and ultimately a commission as a Surface Warfare Officer in 2015.



Prior to his commissioning, Lieutenant Hallissy served afloat on USS Cole (DDG 67) as a Work Center Supervisor, USS Winston S. Churchill (DDG 81) as OT Division's Leading Chief Petty Officer, Commander, Carrier Strike Group EIGHT embarked on USS Dwight D. Eisenhower (CVN 69) as the N39 Leading Chief Petty Officer, and N3 Departmental Leading Chief Petty Officer. Once commissioned, he served as the Electrical Officer, Administrative Officer and EKMS Manager aboard USS Gravely (DDG 107). Lastly, he served on the staff of Destroyer Squadron 23, the "Little Beavers," as the Communications Officer and N6 Officer.

Ashore, Lieutenant Hallissy served on Commander, Task Force 69 in Naples, Italy as a Tactical Watch Officer coordinating and employing submarines deployed to the SIXTH FLEET Area of Operations. Most recently, Lieutenant Hallissy attended the Anti-Surface / Anti-Subsurface Warfare Tactics Instructor Course of Instruction in San Diego, and is currently in a production tour as a Surface Warfare Advanced Tactical Training (SWATT) Planner at Naval Surface and Mine Warfighting Development Center (SMWDC) in San Diego.
