Lt. Jacky White is a native of the town of Oradell, in the Great State of New Jersey. She graduated from The Merchant Marine Academy in 2015 with a Bachelor of Science in Marine Systems engineering and commissioned an Ensign in the U.S. Navy in June 2015.

Her first tour was aboard USS New Orleans (LPD 18) in San Diego, California as the Information Technologies Division Officer and Fire Control Officer. Her collateral duties included wardroom treasurer and Gator Ball coordinator.

Lieutenant White attended Nuclear Power School in August 2017 followed by NPTU Charleston (MTS 635), where she qualified Engineering Officer of the Watch (EOOW) in September 2018.

She checked aboard USS John C. Stennis(CVN 74) in October 2018 and began serving as the Reactor Damage Control Division Officer, then the 1 and 2 Plant Reactor Controls Division Officer. She qualified Propulsion Plant Watch Officer in February 2019, Engineering Officer of the Watch (EOOW), and Reactor Duty Officer (RDO) in April 2020. After passing PNEO in June 2020 with excellence, she served as the Assistant Reactor Training Assistant.

Lieutenant White graduated Amphibious Warfare Tactics Instructor School in May 2021. She participated in BALTOPS50 as part of the response cell on her way to check into Naval Surface and Mine Warfighting Development Center (SMWDC) Headquarters in San Diego. She currently works in N3/7 as an assistant SWATT planner.

Lieutenant White's personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (with 1 Gold Star) and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, as well as multiple unit and service awards.
