

LIEUTENANT JOHNATHAN FALCONE CHIEF ENGINER, USS MANCHESTER (LCS 14) BLUE CREW

Lt. Johnathan Falcone is a Surface Warfare Officer and a native of Flemington, New Jersey. He currently serves as Chief Engineer, USS Manchester (LCS 14), Crew 214.

At-sea, his previous assignments included tours as the Anti-Submarine Warfare Officer aboard USS John S. McCain (DDG 56) in Yokosuka, Japan and Strike Warfare Officer aboard USS Gonzalez (DDG 66) in Norfolk, Virginia. In 2015 he was awarded the United States Naval Academy Class of 1966 Junior Officer Leadership Award.
