



# United States Navy Biography

## LIEUTENANT SAMUEL LIEBER COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER, USS TRIPOLI (LHA 7)

Lt. Samuel Lieber is a native of the New Hampshire Seacoast. He graduated from Norwich University in 2013 with a degree in International Studies and commissioned as an ensign through the school's Reserve Officer Training Corps program.

Upon commissioning, Lt. Lieber reported to USS Higgins (DDG 76) as the Strike Warfare Officer and Legal Officer where he completed a FIFTH and SEVENTH Fleet Ballistic Missile Deployment. During that time, he regularly operated with the Theodore Roosevelt and Harry S. Truman Strike Groups.

From Higgins, Sam reported to USS New Orleans (LPD 18) as the Assistant First Lieutenant and Legal Officer. During New Orleans' FIFTH and SEVENTH Fleet deployment standing Debarkation Control Officer and eventually acting as the ship's First Lieutenant during a critical manning gap.

He then reported to Afloat Training Group San Diego as a Strike Warfare trainer and division officer for Mine Warfare and Anti-Submarine Warfare trainers. Lt. Lieber also assumed the position of Combat Systems Deputy Director. Volunteering his efforts, he was selected as Protocol and Embarkation Officer for Pacific Partnership 2019.

Following his return from Pacific Partnership, he attended the Amphibious Warfare Tactics Instructor Course held by the Surface and Mine Warfighting Development Center detachment in Little Creek Virginia, distinguishing himself as the Honor Graduate.

He currently serves aboard USS Tripoli (LHA 7) as Combat Systems Officer.

Lt. Lieber's awards include multiple Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and various other personal and unit citations.
