Lt. Jonathan Leo, the Planning and Tactics Officer aboard USS Kansas City (LCS 22), hails from the Metro Atlanta town of Norcross, Georgia.

Commissioned from Boston University's NROTC unit, his first sea tour was aboard USS Milius (DDG 69) as the Food Service Officer and Auxiliary Systems Officer. His introduction to the LCS Program was as the Main Propulsion Assistant with LCS Crew 206 aboard USS Coronado (LCS 4) and USS Jackson (LCS 6). During that time, his crew participated in the Independence-variant LCS Total Ship's Survivability Trials (TSST) aboard Coronado and Full Ship Shock Trials aboard Jackson, as well as her sail-around to San Diego.



On shore, he served as a Naval Science Instructor at NROTC Unit Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York before reporting to Kansas City. Lt. Leo has been selected for and will promote to Lieutenant Commander next month.
