A native of Mount Royal, New Jersey, Chief Stetser graduated from Clearview Regional High School in 2004. He enlisted in the Navy in 2004 and is a graduate of Quartermaster “A” School in Great Lakes, Illinois.

His first tour was aboard USS Donald Cook (DDG 75), where he served as Quartermaster and earned his Enlisted Surface Warfare Qualification. In 2008, he transferred to Patrol Coastal Crew (PC) FOXTROT which rotated throughout 13 different PC hulls and earned his Officer of the Deck underway qualification.



In 2010 he transferred ashore to Naval Brig Norfolk where he decommissioned the facility and is a plank owner of Naval Consolidated Brig Chesapeake, serving as Command Duty Officer, Command Master at Arms and Leading Petty Officer (LPO). He transferred afloat in 2014 to USS O’Kane (DDG 77) where he served as Assistant Navigator, Senior Quartermaster, and Navigation division LPO. In October 2017, he transferred to USS Halsey (DDG 97) to serve as Assistant Navigator, Operations Department Leading Chief Petty Officer (DLCPO), and Navigation division Leading Chief Petty Officer (LCPO).

In October 2020, he transferred to Maritime Skills Training Center Pacific to serve as the N70 Quartermaster Schoolhouse LCPO in San Diego, California.

Chief Stetser’s personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (7 awards), Navy Good Conduct Medal (5 awards) and various campaign and unit awards.
