To help you understand a bit more about where your Sailor is serving:

JLC is the fourth ship in the Expeditionary Sea Base class and is named after Sergeant Major John Canley, USMC, a Medal of Honor recipient for his heroism during the Battle of Hué City in the Vietnam War. Our ship is a 785-foot, 90,000-ton mobile sea base designed to support a range of global missions, from aviation operations to small-boat deployments. With a hangar, helicopter landing spots, cranes, and a mission deck, JLC is a versatile platform staffed by 140+ Sailors, 40+ Civilian Mariners, and can support over 200 embarked forces. The ship was delivered to the Navy in March 2023 and now permanently deployed with rotating Blue and Gold military crews.
